

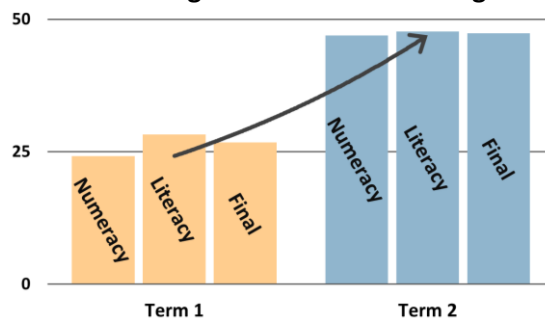


Book Drive!

Literacy in Guyana and GO's Book Club

- GO's afterschool literacy classes for grades 1-3 improves public school grades in reading, writing, and math by an average of 20 grade points each term.
- Most students enroll in our classes start with scores around 20 to 30 points, which is a failing grade of F – below 39. After two terms at GO, grades improve to passing, some with As and Bs.
- GO's Book Club for 4-6 grade improves writing, reading comprehension, and public speaking skills.
- This improvement in primary school grades can reduce the dropout rate in high school with better job opportunities instead of low wages, like cutting sugar cane in the fields.

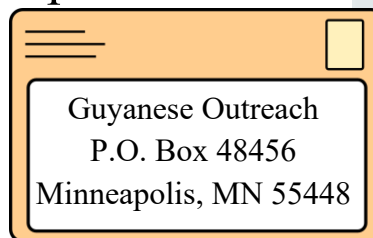
Average Student's Public School Improvement after Enrolling in GO Afterschool Program
